SOFTBALL PLAYERS COUNCIL OPERATING GUIDELINES

The Albert Wallace Marine Park Softball Complex Administrative Rules and Regulations/ League Operational Guidelines provide for the establishment of a Softball Players Council.

The Softball Players Council (SPC) is designed to advise and assist City staff in the operation and management of the softball complex and the associated softball programs. The SPC is comprised of representatives from teams currently participating in league play at the complex, facility and softball program sponsors, and City staff. Representation from all Divisions and Leagues is desired.

Once established, the SPC will meet at least monthly or more often if necessary.

The role of the SPC will be to:

1. Uphold the Albert Wallace Marine Park Softball Complex Administrative Rules and Regulations and League Operational Guidelines.
2. Address non-compliance issues and develop recommendations for disciplinary actions.
3. Uphold and apply the Wallace Marine Park Softball Complex Code of Conduct.
4. Assist City staff with team reclassification if and when necessary.
5. Serve as the first option for the Disciplinary Appeal Process as outlined in the Albert Wallace Marine Park Softball Complex Administrative Rules and Regulations and League Operational Guidelines.
6. Advise City staff with regard to the ongoing development and implementation of the Wallace Marine Park Softball Complex Administrative Rules and Regulations and League Operational Guidelines.
