Division Definitions

1. **Gold** - Players are highly skilled in all aspects of softball play (e.g., hitting, fielding, game/play execution, etc.). The level of play is competitive and consistent from inning-to-inning and game-to-game.
2. **Platinum** - Players have above average skills in all aspects of softball play. Teams have skilled players in most positions. The level of play is somewhat competitive and consistent from inning-to-inning and game-to-game.
3. **Silver** - Players have average skills in all aspects of softball play. The level of play is somewhat competitive but inconsistent from game-to-game.
4. **Bronze** - Players have average or below average skills in all aspects of softball play. The level of play is recreational and inconsistent from game-to-game.
