Division Definitions

1. **Gold**—Players are **highly skilled** in all aspects of softball play (e.g., hitting, fielding, game/play execution, etc.). The level of play is **competitive** and **consistent** from inning-to-inning and game-to-game.
2. **Silver**—Players have **average skills** in all aspects of softball play. The level of play is **somewhat competitive** but **inconsistent** from game-to-game.
3. **Bronze**—Players have average or below average skills in all aspects of softball play. The level of play is **recreational** and **inconsistent** from game-to-game.
4. **Copper**—Players desire to engage in a **recreational activity only**. The main purpose is to exercise, socialize, and have fun.
